The topic for the 2010 prize is

Environmental management and economic use of excessive algal biomass

*Applicants (less than 30 years old) should send before **April 30 /2010***

- A Curriculum Vitae (2 pages maximum)
- a short but consistent and fully explicative abstract of the scientific work (4 pages maximum)
- a copy of the title page of published papers and thesis.

The Daniel Jouvance Prize is awarded yearly since 1992. The 2008 laureate was Ed. Stockdale, University of Western Australia, Crawley, for his work on iron/calcium mineralisation in *Chiton radula*. The 2009 laureate was Aurelie Chambouvet, Marine Station Roscoff, France: Control of Toxic Marine Dinoflagellate Blooms by Parasitic Syndiniales
