



## Marine science on EP

The latest innovations in marine science supporting industries on the Eyre Peninsula will be highlighted at a public seminar in Port Lincoln on Tuesday (October 2).

The seminar, presented by Marine Innovation SA (MISA), will be supported by a display in the Rotary Gallery of research projects based at the Lincoln Marine Science Centre involving MISA partners - Flinders University, SARDI, PIRSA and TafeSA.

The presentation will highlight why Port Lincoln is the national focus for Australia's aquaculture production and innovation, as well as discussing sustainability of wild fisheries and protecting marine resources from pests and diseases.

Tertiary and vocational training opportunities available to the region's current and future generations will also be discussed.

The free event will be held in the Nautilus Theatre, Civic Hall, Tasman Terrace, on Tuesday, October 2, from 5pm to 6.30pm.
